Kern County is now in the Red Zone for COVID-19. This means that we are open inside for dining, just in time to avoid cold outdoor dining. We can have 25% of normal capacity.

If you have a party of more than four, please call ahead for reservations. If a table is not open, please leave your cell number and we will call you when a table is ready. We will sanitize tables and chairs between customers. Please do not move tables. Have a staff member do that for you. We will strictly adhere to the guidelines of the CDC for restaurants.

All guests must wear masks. If you do not have a mask, you will be asked to leave and get a mask. Restrooms will be cleaned every two hours. Masks are required for the safety of our staff. Staff will be gloved and wearing masks for your safety. Gloves will be changed frequently, with hand washing before new gloves are put on. You may remove your mask to eat and drink. Seating is limited due to COVID-19 and social distancing. Seating will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

There is no loitering at tables after your meal is completed and no table hopping to visit others. We want everyone to sit back, enjoy being waited on and enjoy your meal. There will not be any condiments, salt, pepper, sugars or jellies placed on tables. They must be requested. Takeout containers must be filled by customers and available only upon request.
